

## **SPONSORSHIP POLICY**

**Effective May 1, 2023**

**Authority:** Canadian Lakes Property Owners Corporation (CLPOC) Article of Incorporation; Article VI Non-Member Use of Facilities, (B) General Public:

**“Members of the general public, not otherwise eligible under Article VI(A) and VI(B) or Article V(F)...shall not be allowed to use the common facilities, except under limited circumstances as may be approved by the (CLPOC) Board of Directors; provided that at no time shall the (CLPOC) Board of Directors approve any public use which may tend to materially lessen or impair the right of the Corporation’s members to full use and benefit of the common facilities.”**

**Policy:** A Canadian Lakes Property Owner who is also a current Canadian Lakes Pickleball Club member in good standing, may sponsor a non-Canadian Lakes Property Owner who is a current Club member in good standing. Amenity holders are not eligible to sponsor an individual. This policy does not apply to guests of property owners.

### **Definitions:**

**Sponsor** – A Canadian Lakes Property Owner Corporation (CLPOC) member and current Canadian Lakes Pickleball Club (CLPBC) member in good standing, who has received authorization to sponsor an individual.

**Sponsored Individual** – A non-CLPOC member and current CLPBC member in good standing, who has received authorization to be sponsored.

**Amenity Holder** – A temporary CLPOC member.

### **Rules for Sponsors:**

- A sponsor may sponsor only one individual concurrently.
- The sponsor assumes responsibility for ensuring their sponsored individual is made familiar with CLPOC and CLA rules, and acts in accordance with same.
- The sponsor receives and disseminates their sponsored individual’s membership badge, parking pass, applicable Club policies, procedures, and rules.

### **Rules for Sponsored Individuals:**

- A sponsored individual may participate in Community Open Play, and Club Programs and Events, unaccompanied by sponsor.

- A sponsored individual must ensure their club membership remains current at all times, or relinquish their ability to apply for future membership as a sponsored individual.
- A sponsored individual must ensure their parking pass is visible in their vehicle while parked at the courts.
- Sponsored individuals are unauthorized to bring guests.
- Sponsored individuals must have their parking pass on display, and/or their membership badge in their possession, prior to participating in any Canadian Lakes pickleball activities.
- Sponsored individuals are required to comply with the same CLPOC, CLA, and CLPBC rules and regulations that apply to Sponsors.
